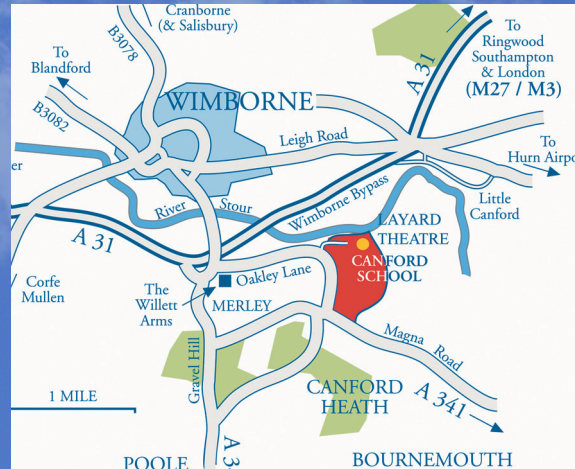
HOW TO FIND US
