The Friends of Canford School (FCS)

1. Friends of Canford School (FCS) advocate a policy of responsible pet ownership and the health and safety of all animals taking part in the competition is our number one concern. Please ensure your pet is willing and able to perform.
2. Canford School and FCS are not responsible for any injuries occurring during the making of videos or photographs taken for entry to the competition.
3. FCS holds the rights to refuse entry into our classes if the subject is felt to be in question.
4. FCS has the right to make changes to the schedule, classes and Best in Show prize.

The Competition

1. Canford cRUFFts is a fun show and is in no way associated with any breed of showing societies.
2. You are not guaranteed a rosette when entering.
3. We have the right to extend the entry date if required.
4. Pet and owner combinations may enter each class as many times as they like.

Permission

1. Entrants must have the permission of the pet owner.
2. Any person under the age of 12 must have parental consent to take part in classes.

Photo & Video Submissions

1. All entrants must have permission to use any and all images they submit and for publication of the names of the owners and pets online.
2. You must have permission from everyone in the image to enter.
3. All images are to be rotated the right way up.
4. No digitally altered images will be accepted unless specified within the class details.
5. Please ensure surroundings and attire are appropriate.
6. All images sent to Canford cRUFFts will be in the public domain.
7. Please ensure you have entered your name and the pet's name in the comments.
8. No captions to be included unless stated in the class rules.
9. Postings may take up to 24 hours to show.
10. Photo and video submissions may only be uploaded if a member of your family has signed up to the event and paid the £9 donation.

The Judges

1. Judges may not enter any classes that they are judging.
2. The judges' decisions are final.
3. The judges will only look at the finalist submissions after Canford School have confirmed the owners have paid an entry fee.
